Online applications are invited from eligible Male \& Female candidates for filling up 272 vacancies for General Central Service, Group 'C' Non-Gazetted, (Non-Ministerial) Combatised posts of Constable (General Duty) under Sports Quota for the year-2023 in Sashastra Seema Bal, Government Of India, Ministry of Home Affairs. The post is temporary, but likely to be continued. Selected candidates are liable to serve anywhere in India or outside the territory of India. On appointment, the candidates shall be governed by SSB Act \& Rules and other Rules applicable from time to time.

(a) A citizen of India, or
(b) A subject of Nepal, or
(c) A subject of Bhutan.

4. PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES:- The post will carry Pay Matrix Rs.21700-69100/- (Level-3) as per $7^{\text {th }}$ CPC and other allowances as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. The selected candidates for the post of CT(GD) under Sports Quota will be governed under Contribution Pension Scheme (New Pension Scheme).

## 5. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR THE POST IS AS UNDER:-


a) In case, a sportsperson produces a document regarding his/her achievement/ certificate after the submission of online application and unto the start of the documentation process, his/her achievement will be accepted and considered documentation process provided the qualifying documents are essentially required with the application form on or before the cut off date.
b) The closing date for receipt of applications will be 30 days from the date of publication of this advertisement in Employment News.
c) The candidate must fulfill all eligibility criteria and must be in possession of all educational/professional/sports achievements and other certificates required for the post, issued by concerned authority till last date of receipt of applications i.e. 30 days from the publication of this advertisement in Employment News.
d) D.O.B. and name as recorded in Matriculation certificate will be accepted for determining the age and name. No subsequent request for its change will be considered.
e) DG, SSB reserves the right to extend the date of receipt of applications, without assigning any reason. If the date for receipt of application will be extended, information in this regard will be uploaded on SSB Recruitment website www.ssbrectt.gov.in
e) All educational certificates and sports certificates other than Central Board/State Board should be accompanied with Government notifications declaring the equivalence of such qualification for service under Central Government.

The candidate will have to produce a certificate to this effect, issued by the concerned District Collector to claim relaxation in age.
(ii) In case of candidates belonging to OBC category, the creamy layer status should have been obtained within preceding three years from the closing date of receipt of application as mentioned at para-5(b) above. The OBC certificate in prescribed format (Annexure-III) issued by a competent authority will only be accepted as proof of belonging to OBC category at the time of documentation.
(iii) Candidate who wishes to avail age relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the concerned Competent Authority, at the time of documentation.
(iv) The candidates seeking relaxation in age under SC/ST category will submit the SC/ST certificate as per Annexure-II issued by the District Authorities at the time of documentation. In the event of non-production of the certificate, their claim for SC/ST category will not be considered and the candidature of candidate will be cancelled straightway. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by SSB at later stage. Candidate is liable for cancellation of his/ her candidature due to non production of SC/ST certificate as per format at the time of documentation.
(v) The candidates seeking relaxation under OBC category should submit the certificate as per Annexure-III issued by District Authorities at the time of documentation. In the event of non-production of OBC certificate in the prescribed format, the candidate will be considered under unreserved category, if he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions prescribed for unreserved category candidate. Certificate on any other format will not be accepted and the candidature of candidate who wants to avail relaxation under OBC category will be cancelled straightaway. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by SSB at later stage and candidate is liable for cancellation of his/her candidature due to non production of OBC certificate as per format at the time of documentation.

## 7.Disqualification:-No person-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
shall not be eligible for appointment to the said post:
Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
8. FEE PAYABLE AND MODE OF PAYMENT: Unreserved, EWS and OBC category candidates are required to pay Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred) only being fees (nonrefundable) through online mode. However, SC/ ST \& Female candidates are exempted from payment of fees.
9. SELECTION PROCESS:-The selection process will be conducted following 02(two) stages:-
a) Stage-I for candidates with International participation/medal winners and National medal winner's unto $3^{\text {rd }}$ place.
b) Stage-II the second stage of recruitment will be conducted for other eligible candidates, if vacancies remained unfilled after selection of candidates having medals/participations in International and medals winners in national competitions pto $3^{\text {rd }}$ place.

The bio-metric examination, photograph and signature of the candidates who report with Admit Card at the recruitment venue will be taken, which shall be followed by conduct of different stages of recruitment process as under:-

## Stage-I:-(For candidates with International participation/medal winners and National medal winner's unto $3^{\text {rd }}$ place)

(a) DOCUMENTATION:- All candidates reporting for recruitment will have to go through documentation process, in which candidates will have to produce all original documents/certificates pertaining to age, education, caste, sports achievements, proof to avail age relaxation etc., failing which the candidature of candidate will be rejected. No appeal on rejection during documentation will be entertained by SSB at later stage.
(b) CHECKING OF SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:- i) Field trial/skill test will be exempted for those who have participated in any International Sports event as member of Indian Squad with clearance of the Department of Youth Affairs \& Sports.
ii) Field trial/skill test will be exempted for those who have represented a State/UT in the Senior or Junior level National championship organized by the National Sports federations recognized by Department of Youth Affairs \& Sports or National Games organized by Indian Olympic Association and have won medals or position upto $3^{\text {rd }}$ place.
iii) Order of preference:- In this process all sports achievements of all candidates will be checked and according to their performance in games the marks will be awarded to them. This process will be maximum of $\mathbf{5 0}$ marks. The order of preference and Division of Marks is as under:-
(i)First preference- Candidates who have represented the country in an International Competition in any of games /sports mentioned at Para-3 with clearance of the Department of Youth Affairs and Sports. Candidates won Gold Medal will be given first preference followed by Silver ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ preference) and then Bronze Medalist ( $3^{\text {rd }}$ preference).

ii) Next preference- Candidates who have represented State/UT in Senior or Junior level National Championship organized by the National Sports Federation recognized by department of Youth Affairs and sports or National Games organized by Indian Olympic association and have won medal or position up to third place. Between the candidates participating or having participated \& won medal in Senior/Junior National Championship/games, latter i.e participated and won medal(s) shall be given preference.
